***Kindergarten:** Change to 5 Full Days may be requested at the semester break in January pending availability in the classroom. The fees will be pro-rated accordingly.

HALF DAY: 8am – 11:30am

FULL DAY: 8am – 3pm

Paying Tuition: We have three different payment options for families:

- 1) Pay full tuition by Monday, August 1, 2019.
- 2) Pay 60% tuition by August 1, 2019 and 40% remaining by December 1, 2019.
- 3) Pay tuition monthly in 10 equal payments from August 1, 2019 to May 1, 2019 (interest **free**).

Deposits: In order to hold your child's place with The Pathfinder School, you must sign and submit your contract to the Main Office upon acceptance with your deposit payment which will be credited toward the remaining tuition due (see below).

- 1) \$500 for the first child
- 2) \$250 for each child thereafter

Extended Day Program: Allows students to participate in after-school activities, as well as provides childcare for families unable to arrive by 3pm dismissal. Billed monthly at a rate of **\$5 per hour**.
Extended Day runs from 3-6pm | Monday-Friday.

Sibling Discount: If a family is not on Financial Aid, laddered discounts are offered for younger siblings. The eldest child always attends at the full tuition.

1st Sibling - 12% | **2nd Sibling** - 15% | **3rd Sibling** - 20%

Annual Campaign: Tuition covers approximately 60% of the cost of educating each Pathfinder Student. The Annual Campaign, along with all other fundraising efforts at Pathfinder, helps to balance the operating budget that funds student programming, faculty salaries, financial aid, buildings and grounds, and more. Fundraising is essential to maintaining the exceptional educational environments that children experience daily, and every Pathfinder family will be asked to participate in the program according to their means.
